Start Up Foodbank

In 2020 we closed all of our Foodbanks and delivered our packs directly to those who needed our support.

128448 meals were provided via 1695 referrals at our Foodbanks.
This supported 3193 individuals over a third of these children.

Start Up Helper Packs

90 Starter Packs given to help people get settled in new tenancies.
114 Welcome Packs to help those in temporary housing.
342 Emergency Food Packs & 339 Toiletry Packs distributed to help the temporary homeless.
